Now, therefore, it is hereby agreed:

SECTION 2- CITY OBLIGATION

Applicant and City certifies program qualifications are met as outlined in Section 1 as of the date of this agreement. Applicant intends to apply for Commercial Tenant Improvement permits on or after the date of this Agreement, and anticipates receiving a permanent Certificate of Occupancy prior to January 31, 2026. Therefore, Gresham agrees to pay or waive the permitting and licensing fees and charges associated with the Applicant's qualifying Commercial Tenant Improvement as described in the Scope of Work.

SECTION 3- APPLICANT OBLIGATIONS

In consideration for the payment and waiver of Applicant's fees and charges by the City pursuant to Section 2 of this Agreement, Applicant specifically agrees:

- a. To payGresham the amount of such fees and charges if Applicant no longer meets program qualifications when Applicant receives a temporary or permanent Certificate of Occupancy.
- b. To pay Gresham the amount of such fees and charges if a permanent Certificate of Occupancy is not issued on or before January 31, 2026.
- c. If payment is due pursuant to Subsections a.or b. of this Section 3, the Citymay withhold the issuance of a temporary or permanent certificate of occupancy for the Commercial Tenant Improvement until payment is received. Applicant agrees not to occupy or use the premises until such payment is made and a permanent Certificate of Occupancy is received.
