- 1. Meeting minutes for June 10, 2025, were approved as written.
- 2. No public comment was presented.
- 3. Transportation System Plan (TSP) Update Jay Higgins: The presentation included an overview of the process and progress of the TSP. The focus of the update was on climate, equity, safety, and emerging technologies. The updates were mostly minor, aligning the TSP with the regional plan. The TSP draft is expected to be completed in the summer of 2025, and adoption is expected by the end of 2025. Discussion included questions and concerns related to the TSP and city transportation planning in general.
- 4. Climate Friendly Equitable Communities (CFEC) Jay Higgins: The purpose of CFEC is to reduce greenhouse gases in Oregon and to create climate friendly areas where people can meet their daily needs without having to drive. The CFEC rules include changes to transportation planning and parking rules. The possibilities concerning the way the parking rules may be applied and enforced were discussed.
- 6. Neighborhood and City News and Reports:
 - a. Neighborhood Services Report: No report (no representative present).
- b. Co-President Report. Carol announced the following: 1) there is an open invitation to the East County Homeless Resource Center (ECHRC) meeting on July 9th, 2 to 3 p.m. The meeting can be attended virtually and will be recorded to be shared. 2) Be aware that scam emails to neighborhood officers are circulating again. There was

some discussion about officers' phone numbers being available on the city's public website.
