

# May 12th, 2026 Hollybrook Neighborhood Association Meeting Notes

## Public Safety & Police Updates

- **Ceasefire Gun Violence Program:** Down from 6 homicides at this time last year to zero.
  - Community Ceasefire tabletop event/discussion & Drone demonstration
- **OSP (Oregon State Police):** Currently has a 10-month backlog for processing rape kits.
- **Community Engagement Page:** There is a comment page available on the community engagement site where we can submit questions or requests for them to attend events.
- **Goals:** Have a lieutenant assigned as a liaison to each neighborhood, to have focus on behavioral health, redeploy school resource officers.
- K-9 officers are doing patrols now.
- 125 of 134 officer positions currently filled, 20 of 24 detective positions filled. 7 officers on duty during the day, 8 at night plus there is overlap between shifts.

## Motorized Vehicles & Trail Safety Concern

- **Springwater Trail:** It is difficult to get specific requests for officers to attend/monitor the trail.
  - They mostly rely on "missions" to address these issues (a directed plan is in place).
  - Enforcement will mostly involve issuing a warning.
  - **Regulations:** If the top speed of the vehicle is 22 mph or less, it is *not* considered a motorized vehicle, and the rider can only get a light fine.

## City & Holiday Operations

- **4th of July:** Fireworks mission planned. This is noted as the most dangerous night in the city. They are currently trying to get more staff on duty.
- **Non-Emergency Phone Number:** There have been a lot of complaints regarding wait times and dropped calls. These route to Portland's system, it isn't managed by Gresham.

## Community Building & Events

- **Goal:** Host socials to build community. Plan involves blocked-off street hours.
- **Communication Channels:** Ways to get information out include Facebook, Nextdoor, postcards, and sharing out the street sweeping schedule.
- **HNA Clarification:** Make sure to tell people that this is **not** an HOA. It is free with no membership required.
