Meetings of the Membership:

Section 7 Notice:

If possible, notice of the next regular meeting shall be given at the previous meeting.

General Electronic Notice on the official Association Webpage on the City Website

Section 8 Quorum:

Quorum shall be the greater of 10 members or twice the number of board officers physically present. If a quorum is not present, all votes will be postponed to the next meeting.

Section 3

Terms of Office:

Each officer shall hold the office until a successor has been elected.

Officers may serve a maximum of three consecutive terms in the same office. After serving three consecutive terms, an individual should wait two years before running again for the same office. Service prior to the adopting of these bylaws shall not count towards the term limit.

Article VII Election of Officers:

Section 2 Eligibility: Candidates shall have participated in at least 2 Association meetings in the previous twelve months. These meetings may include General Association meetings or Executive Board meetings.

Discussion: 2 general meetings and 1 Board meeting.
