- 17640 NE Glisan St. Gresham OR
- 20 two-story Town homes; 10 duplex buildings
- 5, 4, and 3 Bedroom homes; 1 and 1/2 bath
- All units will have zero-step entries and accessible ground floor bathroom
- Landscaped yards, storage units and common green space

- 28 parking spaces, including (3) ADA spaces and multiple EV ready spaces
- NE Glisan Frontage improvements: updated sidewalks, new street trees, bioswales and Trimet Bus stop
- Community Green Space



Myrtlewood Way Project Timeline

- Phase 1 to complete Summer 2026:
 - Glisan St. frontage, street trees & trimet bus stop – Spring 2026
 - Site fencing, landscape, mailboxes and parking lot as well
 - 12 homes to hit CoO by mid Summer!
- Phase 2 to complete Winter 2026:
 - 8 final Homes working toward completion – volunteer opportunities
 - Project complete this Winter!
