


WELCOME



Since 2006, the Portland Immigrant Rights Coalition (PIRC) has been on the front lines, defending the rights of immigrants in our community.



2026




Increase of ICE activity

- Lower number of detentions in January
- Between 2/16 and 2/22: 1 detention
 - 12/1 and 12/17: 94 detentions
- Other detentions in Marion, Multnomah, Clark, Wasco, Linn, Lane, Clatsop, and Clackamas county







End of Year Trends



Counties where people reported being detained



- Shooting and detention of 2 Venezuelan Oregonians has left community terrified.
- Detention of a family with a child when they sought and were denied access to emergency medical care
- Assault of US citizen SEIU union member after profiling
- We have heard that DHS has been preparing to bring Minnesota strategy to Oregon
- Ongoing surveillance and intimidation of observers
- Chemical munitions against protestors and community

DHS agents in our streets with guns do not make Oregon a safe place. **We do.**



Where are we finding hope?

- 39,029 text messages and 20,000 calls to hotline in 2025
- 1,337 visits to PRC November-December
- Supported training of 5,000+ MigraWatchers in Oregon 500-1000 people who attended a vigil for victims of ICE violence

- **Taking action together**





Neighbor to Neighbor!


- **Schools and faith communities are anchors in our neighborhoods**
