ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING CERTAIN RECORDED STREET NAMES TO CONFORM WITH POSTED STREET NAMES AND COMMON USAGE, AND TO AVOID CONFUSION

THE CITY OF GRESHAM COUNCIL FINDS:

1. It is essential that street names be designated for the greatest degree of logic, consistency, and public safety within the adopted city street grid and property numbering system.
2. Conflicts in street names must be eliminated, and street names on official subdivision future street plans must be made to conform with the construction of the subdivision.
3. Certain street names within the City of Gresham need to be corrected in order to avoid confusion and to improve fire/life safety services to the area.
4. The proposed renaming is consistent with address policies and procedures as set forth in the Gresham Comprehensive Plan and Oregon State Statutes.
5. Adequate notice of the proposed renaming was given and a public hearing was held.
6. Punctuation, abbreviations, or use of upper case in the name change text (Items 1-XX below) does not indicate a style preference for purposes of this Street Name Ordinance, but is meant only to provide consistency with the street names, prefixes, and suffixes as originally recorded.

THE CITY OF GRESHAM DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The following street names shall be changed as follows on official records:

1. Change SW BUTLER RD to **SW BINFORD AVE** from the intersection of SW BUTLER RD and SW BINFORD WAY, south to the intersection of SW BUTLER RD and SW BINFORD AVE, as shown on County Tax Assessor Maps 1S3E20AC and 1S3E20AD.
2. Change SW BUTLER RD to **SW 39TH ST** from the intersection of SW BUTLER RD and SW BINFORD AVE, east to the intersection of SW BUTLER RD and SW RODLUN RD, as shown on County Tax Assessor Map 1S3E20AD.
3. Change SW BUTLER RD to **SW RODLUN RD** from the intersection of SW BUTLER RD and SW RODLUN RD, northeast 228 feet to the new SW BUTLER RD, as shown on County Tax Assessor Maps 1S3E20AD, 1S3E21BC, and 1S3E21B.
