Members discussed evacuation routes, collaboration, and what emphasis we, as a Neighborhood Association, want to place on this issue going forward, including dialog with the City.

Treasurer Theresa Tchirky reported that we have \$1,392.85 in our bank account.

Land Use Director Jim Buck reported that the City has received a pre-application for construction of 77 duplex units off of Hogan Rd near Cleveland. The area contains a wetland.
