Public Facilities: Invest in community infrastructure development and redevelopment in low- and moderate-					
income neighborhoods to safeguard public health, improve livability and promote economic development.					
Examples: Park Improvements, Flashing Beacon Crosswalks, Community Centers, ADA Curb Cuts
